UCP OF CENTRAL FLORIDA RAISES \$200,000 AT NINTH ANNUAL FUNDRAISING BREAKFAST IN ORLANDO.

Orlando, Fla. (November 9, 2010) - On Friday, November 5, over 648 guests assembled at First Baptist Church of Orlando to support UCP of Central Florida's ninth annual "Faces Behind the Miracles" Fundraising Breakfast. More than \$200,000 was pledged at the hour-long event.

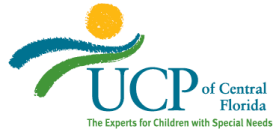
According to Ilene Wilkins, President and CEO of UCP of Central Florida, one of the main goals of the breakfast year after year is to spread awareness about the many services and programs that UCP of Central Florida offers to children and adults with special needs. Most importantly, she said, is the opportunity to raise the critical funds that are needed to continue the non-profit's important work.

"The donations raised at the "Faces Behind the Miracles" Fundraising Breakfast help UCP provide critical support, education, and therapy to children with disabilities who may have gone without," said Wilkins.

This year's event, sponsored by Dr. Donald & Mrs. Cindy Diebel, opened with a powerful introductory video from Edrese Ponder and Senator Bill Nelson. As guests listened, they dined on a continental breakfast with table service. Wilkins then took the stage to present an inspiring plan of UCP's vision for the future: "We must continue to provide the necessary support to our families and the high-level of education and therapy to our children, so that they may lead happy, independent, and productive lives."

Wilkins was followed by the premiere of the inspirational "Together We Can" video, which featured the Lumm and Arthur families and Nicole Encarnacion. When completed, a special message was delivered by Stephanie Arthur and Michelle Incandela. These two parents, holding back tears, shared their highly emotional and joyful experiences of having their children as students and alum of UCP of Central Florida.

The event concluded with a special balloon cutting at guests' tables, sending over a hundred balloons flying into the air. UCP children, families, team members, and special guest vocalist Gina Marie Incandela, daughter of speaker Michelle Incandela, then took the stage in a spectacular finale to end the 2010 "Faces Behind the Miracles" Fundraising Breakfast.
